LAW AND LIBERTY: REFLECTIONS ON CAMPAIGNING BY SHAMI CHAKRABARTI

Shami Chakrabarti is the veteran Director of the leading NGO on civil rights, Liberty. She discusses a lifetime of campaigning on issues affecting all members of society with James Wolffe QC, Dean of the Faculty of Advocates.

The discussion will cover wide ranging topics such as her long battle against the governments proposed 42 days pre-charge detention period in 2008 which she has described as a “long, and dirty, fight” in which Liberty was the subject of “briefing and smears” by the government and others – to her teenage self in 1980s north-west London reading *To Kill a Mocking Bird* and being inspired to live a life of legal campaigning.
